- Encourages individuals experiencing homelessness to take advantage of shelter, housing and services.
- Requires law enforcement officers to offer free shelter and transportation prior to issuing any enforcement violations for camping, storing of personal property or improperly using public lands.
- Provides information about housing options to individuals in shelters.
