



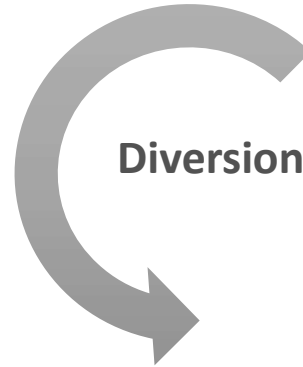
## What are some components of a Coordinated Entry System?



Clients living in a place not meant for habitation can receive same assistance as others in C.E.P.

Connect unsheltered directly to services by:

- ✦ Connecting the client to an Access Point directly
- ✦ Choosing to serve as an Access Point
- ✦ Providing a warm hand-off to an Access Point



A strategy that can end homelessness before it begins. A special diversion assessment tool will be used to determine:

- ✦ Which is appropriate **prevention** or **diversion**?
- ✦ Will client need emergency shelter or enter coordinated entry system?
- ✦ 2-1-1 Suncoast will provide both prevention or diversion referrals



Access Points for Oneby1 will be the starting point that leads to housing for homeless clients.

- ✦ Locations, hours, and contact information will be published
- ✦ Walk-ins should be accepted (not to say there won't be a wait).
- ✦ Intake staff may find that prevention or diversion is the best course.

Four Activities will take place at Access Points and be completed in 3 day maximum:

- ✦ Intake
- ✦ Prioritize / ViSPDAT and Local Prioritization Questions
- ✦ Eligibility and Choice
- ✦ Referral and Personal Introduction
