EMERGENCY

PLAN NOW



- Know the closest hurricane evacuation shelter and pickup sites! Dial 941-749-3500 or visit: www.mymanatee.org/emergency
- If you have special medical needs that will require evacuation to a Special Needs Shelter, REGISTER NOW! Call 941-749-3500 or visit: www.mymanatee.org/needs
- BEFORE THE STORM listen for announcements.
- Watch the local media for updates on the storm. Look for notices at local agencies, on local media, websites, Code Red App, FEMA App
- DO NOT WAIT! When notice is given, go immediately to hurricane evacuation shelter or pickup site.

SHELTERS



Hurricane evacuation shelters will be open for anyone seeking a safe place to stay during a tropical storm or hurricane.

EVACUATION



- Free bus transportation from homeless evacuation pickup sites to emergency shelters (wheelchair accessible).
- For safety, bus service transportation is suspended when local winds reach 40 miles per hour.
- Once you arrive at the shelter, stay at the shelter until you are told it is safe to leave.

AFTER THE STORM



Return Buses: After it is safe, you can receive free bus transportation back to your initial pickup location.
