In the following meetings, we will discuss Access Points, the VI-SPDAT, how our CoC Prioritizes for Referrals, the flow of Coordinated Entry, the By-Name Lists, Shelters and Transitional Housing options, Rapid Re-Housing and Permanent Supportive Housing, how we Evaluate Our System, Case Conferencing, Client Input, and Support Services.

Each person may choose one meeting to participate in so that we have room for everyone to be a part of these discussions. This is the information gathering phase of the overall review process. There will be future meetings to discuss the results and recommendations from these sessions.
